**Encouraging constructive feedback: self/others**

**A. ORGANISATION**

**Introduction**

- Did it get attention?
- Did it orientate listener to the theme?
- Was it an appropriate length?

**Structure**

- Did the sermon have a central idea?
- Was the development/structure clear?
- Did the different parts hold together?
- How did the structure of the sermon relate to the structure of the passage?

**Conclusion**

- Did the sermon build to a conclusion?
- Were there effective closing appeals or suggestions?

**B. CONTENT**

- Was the subject of the sermon significant?
- Was the sermon true to Scripture?
- Was the sermon true to life?
- Did the content show freshness/originality?
- Did it seem that the speaker had been engaged by the content?
- Was it clear that the speaker was well prepared?

**Supporting Material (Illustration)**

- Was the supporting material used related to the point?
- Was it interesting, varied, sufficient?
- If humour was used, was it appropriate?

**C. DELIVERY**

**Language**

- Did speaker use correct grammar?
- Did choice of words add to effectiveness of sermon?

**Oral Presentation**

- Could the speaker be heard?
- Was there variety in volume and tone?
- Was the volume and tone appropriate to the content being communicated?

**Physical Presentation**

- Was the speakers entire body involved in the delivery?
- Were there good facial expression?
- Were gestures used appropriate?
- Were there any recurring, distracting mannerisms?
- Did speaker refer to notes too often?
- Did speaker convey confidence?

**Audience Engagement**

- Was there good eye contact?
- Did you feel speaker was talking to you?
- Did speaker come across as friendly?
- Was speaker aware of audience reaction?
- Was the sermon an appropriate length?
- In what way did sermon impact you: e.g. encouraged, encountered, taught, challenged?
