“An Appointment With The Lord”

I guess most of us are busy people:- work, family and friends, our own church needs us especially in these days, etc.

Some people wonder why, at 76, I still get up early EVERY morning ! The answer is "I have an appointment with the Lord!"

It really IS true that "they who wait for the Lord shall renew their strength" (Isa 40.31 ESV). Jesus told His disciples "Come with Me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest" (Mark 6.31 NIV). He DIDN'T say "You need a holiday abroad". He DID say we need to WAIT ON HIM (Psalm 62.1 ESV) " For God alone my soul waits in silence; from Him comes my salvation". Psalm 123 encourages us to LOOK TO GOD. Andrew Murray says, "It is because Christians do not know their relation to God of absolute poverty and helplessness that they have no sense of the need of absolute and unceasing dependence, or the unspeakable blessedness of continual waiting on God".

I have recently been reading through Exodus. In Ex.24 the people firmly declare "we will obey the Lord", but seven chapters later they cannot wait for Moses to return after his 40 days and nights up the mountain with God, and they fall into the most awful idolatry.

However, in Acts 1.14 the followers of the Lord Jesus Christ WAITED In PRAYER CONSTANTLY and were together in one place when the Day of Pentecost came, and they were filled with the Holy Spirit. That's the answer to our needs!
