

### “Is OUR testimony real and effective?”

Have you heard of PPS? i.e. Parliamentary Prayer for Scotland. They are a group of praying Christians who meet together each week that Parliament is in Session in order to pray for both Scottish and Westminster Governments. We wear bright red tops - a symbol of commitment for life to the Lord Jesus Christ Who gave His life for us. The MSP's recognise us in the Chamber as the folk who pray for them.

Two weeks ago I was given two books to read; both of them were testimonies to the power of the 'blood of the Lamb' and the ongoing work of the Holy Spirit transforming the lives of these two very different people. I was excited to read Hugh Hill's story because we heard about him back in the 1980's but had never met Hugh until this last year. His mother lived here in Pittenweem, and now that he has retired his book is being used as an evangelistic tool in a number of churches.
