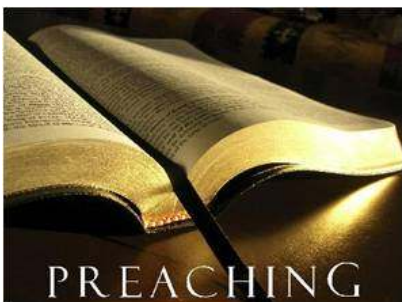

“Salt”

When it comes to looking after ourselves physically, doctors advise us not to take too much salt in our diet. From a spiritual perspective, the Lord Jesus said to his disciples, ‘You are the salt of the earth, but if the salt has lost its taste, how shall its saltiness be restored?’ Matthew 5:13. Have you ever considered the connection between yourself and the salt metaphor? It would be a healthy exercise for all of us to be still in the Lord’s presence and quietly consider these questions:

1. Salt is a preservative. What am I doing to preserve those in my community who are at risk or are perishing? Am I doing my part to preserve them from eternal punishment?
2. Salt heals wounds. It might sting and hurt but what am I doing to heal wounds and hurts in my neighbourhood?
3. Salt adds a positive flavour. What flavour am I adding to conversations with the people I meet?
4. Salt must be applied to have its impact. It doesn’t make an impact if it’s kept in the shaker. It must come out to have an effect. If our Christian witness is kept in private, the real impact of my Christian life will not be realised.
