

“My heart is fixed O Lord”

That’s what David declared in Psalm 57:7 and again in Psalm 108.

Now I want to be able to say that too...my heart is fixed. To say, I have a walk with the Lord that is steady and stable, that is solid and true. But how does God work that kind of stability and steadiness in us?

He puts us in a fix – to fix us,

The Lord loves us just as we are, but He loves us too much to let us stay that way, so often He puts us in a fix - to fix us. Let’s consider the Disciples, they had to go through a couple of storms on the sea of Galilee, until their hearts were fixed, until their faith was stabilised.

They had to go through the same fix of seeing crowds of people, 5000 men on one occasion and 4000 men on another and be asked of the Lord, to feed and take care of them when it seemed there wasn’t enough resources to do so.

The Lord keeps on putting his disciples in those similar situations, almost identical situations until they start to get it right. Those tests, those trials and difficulties that we go through are all for a purpose and God will keep bringing that test your way until you pass it.

God says it’s because I love you, I’m right beside you and I’m going to see you through this difficulty.

You might feel like you’re in a real fix today?

Take hope, take heart because God loves you and is faithful. Trust in the Lord, look to the Lord and lean on the Lord. Let him do what he is determined to do and that’s to fix us, that we too might say like the Psalmist “ My heart is fixed O Lord”
